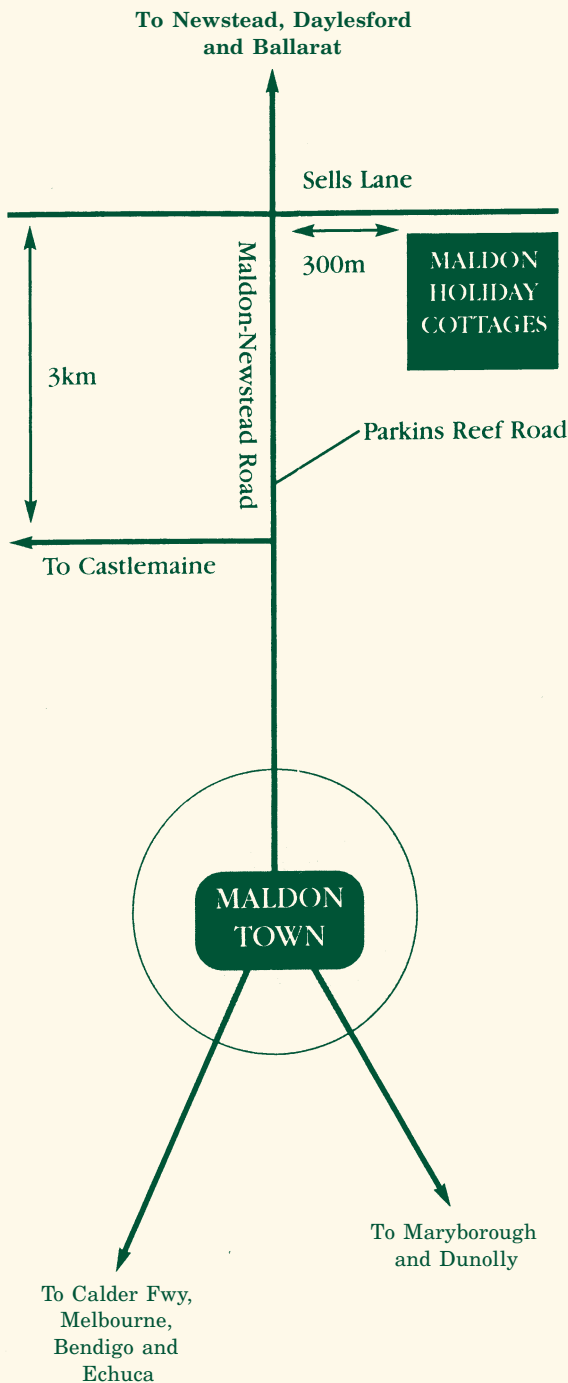
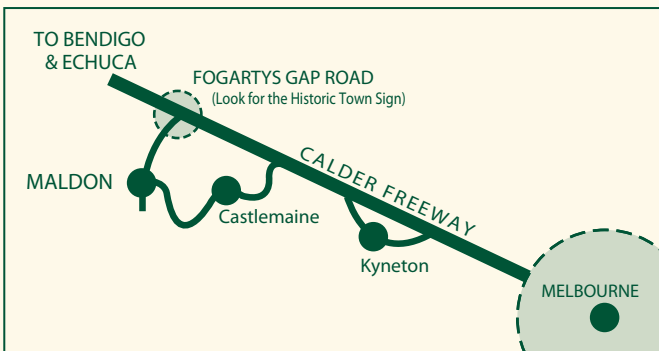

- ❖ Maldon Holiday Cottages are located on a 40 ha property adjoining the Maldon Historic Reserve and are surrounded by forest and farms.

- ❖ The Hepburn Springs Spa Complex is 30 minutes away.
- ❖ Excellent wines, especially reds, are made in Central Victoria and there are six wineries that are no more than 30 minutes drive, and many more within an hour. The delightful Welshmans Reef Vineyard is only 5 minutes away.
- ❖ Lake Cairn Curran is 10 minutes away.
- ❖ Our property adjoins the forest and is very peaceful – you are welcome to roam.
- ❖ Bring your bicycles or your pets, though dogs must not be allowed to roam unsupervised.
- ❖ Play a round of golf at Maldon with its sand scrapes.
